RE: Cavern Oaks Subdivision, Comal County. Edwards Aquifer Rule
156.20.05.008.

This is in response to your request for approval of a water pollution abatement plan for the above referenced subdivision in Comal County. The plan has been reviewed pursuant to Texas Water Development Board Rule 156.20.05.008 which specifies water pollution abatement activities for subdivisions located on the Recharge Zone of the Edwards Aquifer.

As outlined in the application, this subdivision will consist of thirty-three single-family lots and two commercial lots. Sewage disposal will be by means of individual septic tanks.

The construction standards and pollution abatement activities proposed by the applicant are in general agreement with Rule No. 156.20.05.008 and the subdivision plan is approved. The developer shall comply with all applicable provisions of Texas Water Development Board Rule 156.20.05 and shall be responsible for compliance with such provisions until such responsibility is legally transferred to another person or entity. The use of septic tanks is only approved for the disposal of sanitary sewage. The development of the commercial lots for activities producing wastewaters other than normal domestic sewage must be preceded by approval of the Department.
